

Anne Arundel Community College Financial Aid Information

Anne Arundel Community College offers more than 180 different institutional scholarships annually. Each scholarship has its own requirements based on merit, need, academic objective and other criteria. All students are encouraged to apply by completing a **single application** which will place them in consideration for every scholarship for which they are eligible. In addition, scholarship applicants must complete a Free Application for Federal Financial Aid (FAFSA) even if the student believes they are not eligible for federal financial aid and include the college institution code 002058. Scholarship awarding begins April 15 and will continue until all scholarships are awarded.

Through the generous support of the AACC Foundation the college has established the Anne Arundel County Principals' Scholarship to provide financial assistance to a deserving high school graduate who has demonstrated academic potential from each of the 12 county public high schools. The scholarship will be dispersed in the amount of \$1,000 per semester for the first year of attendance at Anne Arundel Community College.

How do I apply?

After completing your application <https://a49recws.aacc.edu/Admissions/Pages/welcome.aspx> to Anne Arundel Community College and establishing your password, visit www.aacc.edu and select the MyAACC tab. Use your password to log into MyAACC, go to the Menu in the upper left hand corner and select "Self Services," then "Credit Student," then "Financial Aid." Click on "Apply for Grants, Loans and Scholarships," and then "Apply for Scholarships." This will take you to an online application that will interface with your student record. Note: Any false information provided will result in the immediate disqualification of the student from receiving any awards and possible disciplinary action from the college.
