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## AP Pre-Administration Dates

South River will hold AP Pre-Administration on Tuesday April 5th in the cafeteria. Sessions are broken down according to grade-level and last name. The make-up date will be Wednesday, April 6th.

AP Pre-Administration is held because it is one of the best ways to save time on exam day! During this session, students complete their identification information on their answer sheet for their first AP exam that they will be taking throughout the duration of AP exams so they won't have to take time to do this on exam day. This answer sheet is called a student's registration answer sheet because it is the first AP answer sheet that a student fills out in a given school year. It takes about 30 minutes for students to complete this information, during the session. Each student should fill out only one registration answer sheet regardless of the number of exams that he or she will take.

Students will need to plan to be here at SRHS during their assigned date and time for Pre-Administration. Please see the schedules to the right for when you are assigned to come to the cafeteria and complete your AP Pre-Administration. **\*\*On the two days, students will be called over the intercom.**

# Bus Transportation

(Students who already turned in their bus transportation forms)

If you are taking the bus from South River to Riva Trace in the morning you MUST be on the bus #TBA by 7:10 am.

If you are taking the bus from South River to Riva Trace for an afternoon exam, you MUST be on the bus in the front of the school by 11am.

If you are taking the bus from Riva

Trace to return back to South River after a morning exam, you MUST be on the bus in the front of the church at 11:30am.



# Arrival and Dismissal Procedures

## Arrival Procedures:

All AP Exams are at Riva Trace Baptist Church this year, including AP Spanish Language, AP French Language from May 2 - 13, 2016 (please see the AP Exam schedule). The length of AP tests varies by subject. Exams take approximately 3 - 3 1/2 hours of ACTUAL TESTING TIME. Adding one 10-minute break between sections and time to distribute, collect and count of materials results in morning AP exams ending around 11:45 a.m. and afternoon AP exams ending around 4:00 p.m. Students taking the afternoon exams will NOT BE FINISHED IN TIME TO RIDE THE AFTERNOON SCHOOL BUS AND THERE IS NOT A BUS RETURNING BACK TO SRHS FROM RTBC.

**MORNING EXAMS-** Arrive at the church by 7:15 a.m. and be in your testing room by 7:30am. Students

should not ask to leave early if they finish before the end of the test, as their requests will be denied.

**AFTERNOON EXAMS-** Arrive at the church by 11:15 a.m. and be in your testing room by 11:30 a. m. **No student will be dismissed until an exam has officially ended.** Students should not ask to leave early if they finish before the end of the test, as their requests will be denied. Students who play a sport or have a job are responsible for informing coaches or employers of AP obligations and making arrangements accordingly.

## Students Self-Transporting

Enter the church parking lot and find locate an open parking spot.

ONLY enter through the Gymnasium Entrance in the rear of the church.

When leaving, if parked near the gymnasium entrance, loop back around and go against the direction pattern to avoid the pre-school traffic, which will be in session. Once the student exits the church, they will not be able to re-enter the church.

## Student Drop Off/Pick-Up

Student Pick-Up and Drop Off- ONLY at the Gymnasium Entrance in the rear of the church. Please loop around the Gymnasium lot and go against the direction pattern to avoid the pre-school traffic, which will be in session.

# Food, Drink and Cell phones

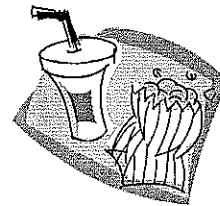
Students may pack a water bottle and healthy snack – both labeled with the student's first and last name to have during the break. These will be stored along the walls of the testing room during the test administration.

A student taking two exams on the same day need to bring their lunch as there is not enough time between exams to leave the testing site!

Cell Phones and all electronic devices are prohibited at the testing location. Please leave all cell phones in your cars or at home for the duration of testing.

Students are required to abide by the policies of both the College Board and South River High School during the exam period. Any misconduct will be reported and could jeopardize AP Exam grades. If you decide not to take an exam, please inform Crystal Hanson as soon as possible prior to the test ad-

ministration. Students should get a good night's rest before the tests, and eat a nutritious breakfast.
