What is it?

Relay For Life is a fun-filled overnight **walkathon** event designed to celebrate survivorship and raise \$\$\$ for the American Cancer Society (ACS). Anyone from the school or community can start a team or you can register as an individual. This year's theme is "Sports," so your team should pick a sport and decorate your campsite based on it.

How do I register?

The cost is free! You can sign up by visiting www.relayforlife.org/southaacomment. Scroll down to see the list of teams and click on one to join or start your own.

How much money do I have to raise?

The goal is to raise at least \$100 in donations and you are rewarded with a T-shirt that you wear as a badge of honor! The more money you raise, the bigger your incentive prize...everything from a t-shirt to a Fitbit or flat screen TV!

How do we honor cancer survivors?

We invite cancer survivors and their caretakers to join us for a free catered dinner at 4:30pm in SRHS's cafeteria. If they are able, cancer survivors also take the first lap at 6:15pm and are honored & remembered at the luminaria ceremony at 9:30pm. Luminaria can be purchased online or at the event.

What do team captains have to do?

- Get at least 7 people to be on the team and make sure at least one is walking at all times
- Collect donations from team members and turn them in at one of the monthly Relay participant meetings or at the Relay event
- Encourage team members to reach \$100 in donations and help with fundraising ideas (suggestions are online and given at the monthly Relay participant meetings)
- Decide if your team would like to do a fundraiser the night of the Relay (selling food or jewelry, having a silent auction, operating a game, etc.) and notify the ACS about it
- Provide updated information about the event to your team members

When are the participant informational meetings?

March 21st, April 18th, and May 30th. All meetings are at 7pm in SRHS's cafeteria.

What goes on at Relay for Life?

It's a party atmosphere with special events, games, food, giveaways, bands, an opportunity to donate hair, and lots to buy!

Where does your money go?

To research for a cure, advocacy efforts, prevention/awareness efforts, and support to victims.
