## Steps to Enroll

- Complete the online AACC application at:

- Complete **the Early College Access Program (ECAP) form** & submit to your guidance counselor. Submit SAT READING score (500), ACT ENGLISH score (18) to AACC OR Mrs. Bennett OR take AACC Accuplacer assessment.
- Register for your spring class(es) **Nov. 14 - Nov. 28** during NEST in the AACC office (Mrs. Bennett, Media 3) & bring your completed ECAP form.
- Pay your bill by the deadline date noted on the bill.
